
# Defining global competence in PISA












Global competence builds on specific cognitive and socio-emotional skills, including

- Reasoning with information
- Communication in intercultural contexts
- Perspective-taking
- Conflict resolution
- Adaptability



**Openness** towards people from other cultural backgrounds

**Respect** for cultural differences

**Global-mindedness** 

### The PISA instruments

#### **Cognitive test**

 A test of "global understanding": background knowledge + cognitive skills necessary to successfully navigate global and intercultural issues

#### Questionnaire

- Students: self-reported data on the other components of global competence (e.g. openness, adaptability)
- Principals and teachers:
   self-reported data on
   activities related to global
   and intercultural
   education

#### **Example of scenario in the cognitive test**

Last weekend your team lost because the foreign-born player decided to walk off the pitch leaving his team to play 10 against 11 after receiving racial insults. As you talk with a friend about this episode, you realise that both you and your friend have always referred to the foreign-born player by his nickname "the Animal". The captain of your team is nicknamed "the Brain".

What is a possible consequence of this choice of nicknames?
